Where to Stay

- **Country Inn & Suites**
Located near I-75, Country Inn & Suites allows dogs up to 20 pounds for a \$25 fee per stay.
- **Holiday Inn Express**
The Holiday Inn Express & Suites is also located near I-75 and will allow dogs up to 50 pounds for a \$25 fee for 1-3 nights.
- **TownePlace Suites by Marriott**
TownePlace Suites by Marriott is located directly on Tiffin Avenue in Findlay and has no weight limit for dogs; pets may stay for a \$75 fee.

What to Do

- **Van Buren State Park**
Located 1.5 miles from I-75, the Van Buren State Park is pet-friendly. There are numerous walking paths, bridle trails, disc golf, fishing, boating and more!
- **K-9 Field of Dreams**
The K-9 Field of Dreams park in Findlay is an off-leash park in the Riverbend Recreation Area. This one acre park is divided into a small dog area (for dogs less than 30 pounds) and a large dog area. Dogs must be legally licensed, vaccinated and wear dog tags.
