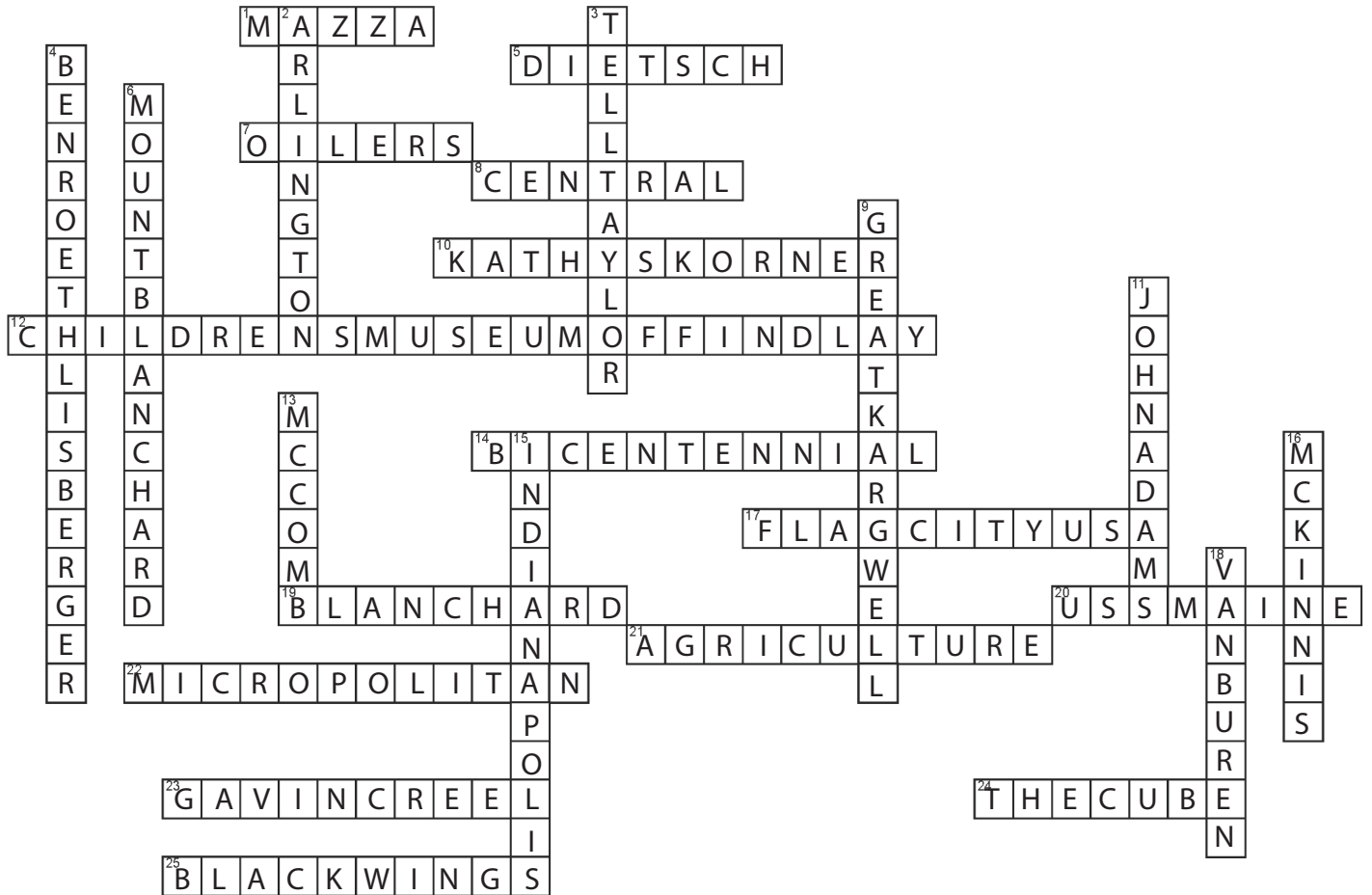




Visit Findlay! Crossword
