Museums

Museums get a bad rap for being dry and boring, but not in Findlay! Pack up the kids and head to any of our museums for a fun and (shhh!) educational day out. **Children's Museum of Findlay** has exhibits and activities for babies - elementary age kids. Children will learn about local industries (like farming, education, parks, and more!) all while playing. **Mazza Museum**, located on University of Findlay's campus, is where love of art is born. This unique art museum is made up entirely of children's book illustrations and is a favorite of every child who visits. **Northwest Ohio Railroad Preservation** is home to a railroad museum, model train collections, and 2 quarter-scale trains that will take children ages 0-100 on a ride around the grounds. Other museums include **Hancock Historical Museum**, **Black Heritage Library**, **Hancock Sports Hall of Fame**, **Findlay Art League**, and MCPA's **Fisher/Wall Art Gallery**.
